

Atlantis Synchronized Swimming Athlete Code of Conduct

Athletes and parents must acknowledge they have read and understood the Swimmer Code of Conduct on the registration form prior to commencing the season.

Athletes are expected to:

1. Demonstrate a positive attitude towards the sport of synchronized swimming.
2. Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
3. Treat coaches and fellow swimmers with courtesy and respect.
4. Be courteous to fellow competitors, other club coaches, and officials, and to conduct themselves appropriately.
5. Be in attendance at and be on time for all swim meets.
6. Support club swimmers by sitting together and cheering for all ASSC events
7. Follow all pool safety rules while on pool decks and in the change rooms. There is zero tolerance of:
 - Offensive language,
 - Rude or offensive behavior,
 - Angry outbursts or disorderly behavior,
 - Abuse of athletes, coaches, or officials,
 - Use of alcohol, cigarettes or illegal drugs,
 - Use of electronic communication devices and/or cameras in change areas.
8. The coaching staff may solicit feedback from swimmers from time to time and this is expected to be open, honest, and constructive.
9. Discipline will be applied as outlined in the ASSC Discipline Policy.
10. The ASSC Executive, at its discretion, may terminate with notice a swimmer's membership in ASSC and the athlete will forfeit swim fees or other costs incurred by the athlete up to one full month after termination prior to January 1st, after which all swim fees may be forfeited.
