Atlantis Athlete Code of Conduct

Athletes are required to demonstrate a positive attitude toward the sport at all times. Athletes are expected to be courteous and show respect towards all athletes, coaches, parents/guardians and officials at all times. Athletes are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. This includes cheering as a club for all Atlantis athletes at competitions, congratulating competitors on their performance, and remaining strong in the face of not meeting goals.

Athletes are expected to demonstrate the principles of fair play:

1. Respect the rules
2. Respect the officials and their decisions
3. Respect your opponent
4. Give everyone an equal chance to participate
5. Maintain your self-control at all times

Athletes are expected to abide by the Club Attendance Policy, without fail. This policy covers:

- Illness or injury
- School events
- Multi-sport athlete absences
- Special life event absences
- Lateness
- Inattentiveness
- Electronic device use

Non-adherence may result in sanction or dismissal from the team.

Athletes must follow facility safety and other rules at all times. When representing Atlantis, there is zero tolerance of:

- Offensive language
- Rude or offensive behaviour
- Angry outbursts or disorderly behaviour

The use of alcohol, cigarettes or illegal drugs for underage athletes, even when not representing Atlantis, will result in sanction or dismissal from the team.

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Atlantis Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

Parents/guardians must demonstrate a positive attitude, be courteous, and show respect towards all athletes, coaches, swimmers, parents/guardians and officials.

Whether observing practice or at a competition, there is zero tolerance of:

- Offensive language
- Rude or offensive behaviour
- Angry outbursts or disorderly behaviour

Parents/guardians are expected to show good sportsmanship at all times.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to discuss progress and concerns with their child's coach(es), or to bring concerns to the Head Coach. Meetings must take place before or after practices or competitions, at a time and place agreed to by the coach and parents/guardians. Unless meetings are cursory in nature, they *must* be pre-set.

Parents/guardians may not interfere with practices or competitions.

- Parents/guardians are allowed on the pool deck to watch so long as they are away from the pool edge and do not interfere with practice or speak to their child.
- Parents/guardians are not allowed on the pool deck at competitions, or during testing unless they are working as a sanctioned official.

One parent/guardian from each family must attend the year-start mandatory parent/guardian meeting.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to attend the season-end AGM and Athlete banquet.

Atlantis is a volunteer-run club. Parent/guardian volunteers are essential to the club's existence. To that end, each family is required to assist in at least one event per year, such as a competition, banquet, fundraising event, or as a board member.

Parents/guardians must read, understand, and adhere to the Atlantis Policy and Guidelines.
